


## Research Collections: Archives

### Searching for Scottish Trades Union Congress (STUC) records on the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC)

#### Guide for users

- Location - The catalogue is available online and is accessible from any computer with internet access <http://ilink.gcal.ac.uk/uhtbin/webcat>
- There is also a paper version of the catalogue and a subject index which can be viewed in the Archive.
- Ways of searching: keyword; title; author or name; series; journal title.
- All the records are full text searchable. This means you can enter any keyword and all relevant records from the Archive will appear along with any other relevant material catalogued on the library system. Items found via a search will be displayed in chronological order with the most recent first.
- The STUC records are linked by a hierarchical structure which is available online and in the catalogue. This is displayed in the online catalogue in the upwards and downwards links.
