# HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE MEETING OF SENATE HELD ON 16th MARCH 2012

The main highlights from the meeting of Senate were as follows:

### **Staff Opinion Survey**

An outcome from the Staff Opinion Survey is the establishment of a new forum called Staff Voice. This forum is in addition to the already established channels such as Principal's Listening Events to further improve communication.

#### **Professor Yunus and the Grameen Scotland Foundation**

Professor Yunus delivered a Masterclass on Social Business to students and staff of the University during a recent visit. In addition his visit also promoted the work of the Grameen Scotland Foundation. The Cabinet Secretary John Swinney is supportive of the establishment of the Grameen micro credit initiative in Scotland. This high profile and successful visit raised around £1m in pledges in support of the work of the Grameen Scotland Foundation.

#### **Composition of School Boards**

Senate agreed to revise the composition of School Board membership to include part-time staff. This change will take effect from session 2012/13.

#### **Review of Higher Education Governance**

#### **IT and Campus Improvements**

The University's campus master plan is a 15-20 year vision with a capital investment of £25m. The Heart of the Campus project will create innovative learning and teaching facilities, additional social space building on the concept of the Saltire Centre and improved Refectory facilities. The designated architectural team will be consulting with all interested parties to inform the design strategy in due course. The University is also investing in a combined Heat and Power installation system. Work will commence on this in April.
