

How do I register with the police?

Some students are required to register with the police after arriving in the UK with a visa, or after extending a visa to stay longer in the UK.

You must register within 7 days of arriving in the UK. An appointment must be scheduled with the Overseas Visitor Registration Office (OVRO). You will be given a Police Registration Certificate (PRC) which you must store safely and keep updated.

Notifying the Police of any changes

You must inform the Police within **7 days** of any change. You can do this at your local police station. Find your nearest police station at www.scotland.police.uk/police-stations/greater-glasgow/

What if my Police Registration Certificate is lost or stolen?

Report this to your local Police Station and notify the VISA Team immediately. You will need to make an appointment to get a new Police Registration Certificate and you may be charged.

What do I need to register with the Police for the first time?

- ✓ Your Passport and visa/Biometric Residence Permit (BRP) card
- ✓ Two passport-sized photographs
- ✓ Registration fee of £34
- ✓ Proof of address required from an 'official body'
- ✓ Your offer letter or CAS
