- **Common Good Curriculum**

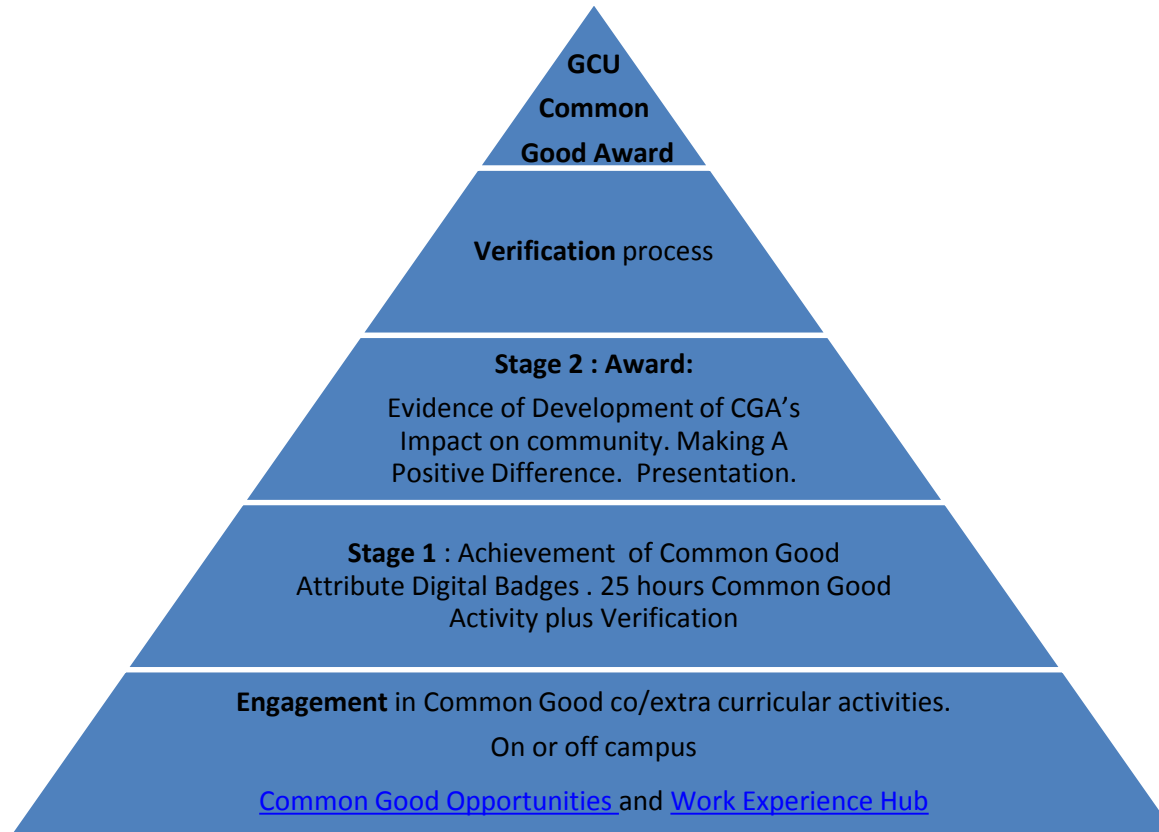
The term 'curriculum' in this sense refers to the totality of the GCU student learning experience, both formally within the taught curriculum and informally through *co- and extra-curricular activities*

# THE COMMON GOOD AWARD

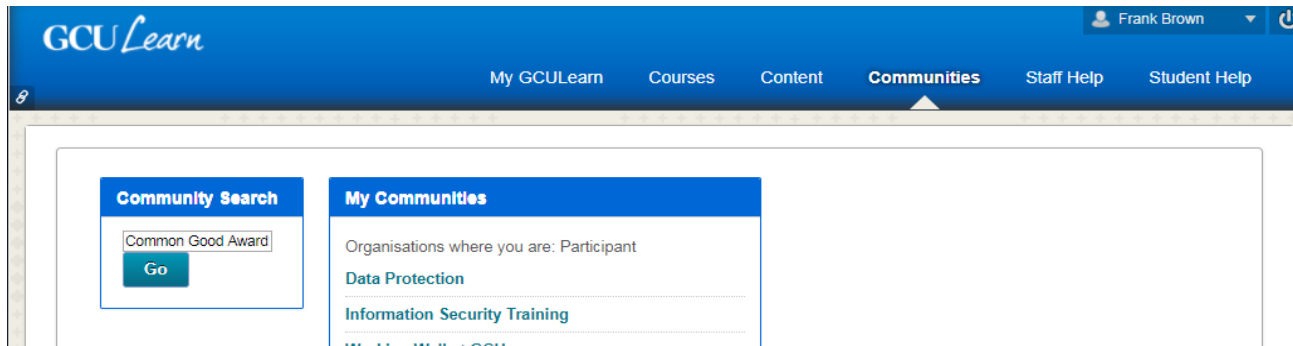
- Personal development and skills award.
